Govt. Maharani Laxmibai, P.G. Girls College is a Govt. funded college affiliated to D.A.V.V. Indore. It is a multi-faculty college and offers a wide range of under graduate & post graduate programmes. At under graduate Level 06 programmes are offered (B.A., B.Sc., B.Com, B.B.A., Library Science and B.Sc. Home Science). 15 programmes are offered at Post graduate Level (M.A. Hindi, English, Political Science, History, Sociology, Economics, Psychology, Instrumental Music, Drawing & Painting and Dance), M.Sc. (Chemistry and Bio-chemistry), M.Sc. Home Science (Food & Nutrition, Textiles & Clothing) and M.Com .

At under graduate Level unified syllabus, designed by the Department of Higher Education, Bhopal is followed. For Post-graduate programmes , syllabus is prescribed by the university. The institution has a limited flexibility to from the syllabus.

The institution follows a academic calendar, issued by the Department of Higher Education MP. At the beginning of the session, Principal holds the staff council meeting, in which the entire chalked out plan is discussed and conveyed to the staff for the effective implementation of the curriculum. the teachers strictly follow the time-table prepared by the college. The institute extends its full support by providing all the facilities like separate departments, computers, ICT facility, internet and departmental library to improve teaching practices.

All science professors of the college being Dean, chairpersons and members of Board of studies of the university play a vital role in the development of curriculum for the Post-graduation, M.Phil. and Ph.D. entrance exams. Govt. Maharani Laxmibai P.G. Girls College earlier known as Govt. New Girls College was established in 1965 (shifted from a school where it was founded in 1963) within a fort which was constructed by the Holkar State in 1860. It is situated in urban location. The campus of college spreads over 13 acres with a built-up area of 7568.23 sq. meters. The institution is affiliated to Devi Ahilya University, Indore and is recognized by UGC under section 2(f) and 12(b).

**(iii) History of the college with significant milestones**

Govt. Maharani Laxmibai P.G. Girls College, earlier known as Govt New Girls College was established in 1965 (shifted from a school where it was founded in 1963) within a fort which was constructed by the Holkar State in 1860. It is situated in urban location.

There has been a constant increase in the admission graph of students. The college began with a modest number of 28 students and at present the strength of college is 4648. The college has been imparting education to the girls in six streams viz Arts, Science, Commerce, Home Science, Business Administration and Library Science. The Departments of Commerce, Bio-chemistry, Bio-technology, Library Science, Computer Science and Business Administration are running under self-financing scheme. The college has 25 Departments with a total strength of 85 faculty members, out of which 52 are regular and 28 are temporary teachers. The non-teaching staff comprises of 46 employees.

In under graduate there are 05 disciplines comprising of – B.A., B.Sc., B.HSc. B.Com., B.B.A. and in post graduate we have M.A., M.Sc., M.H.Sc. , M.Com. and B.Lib.

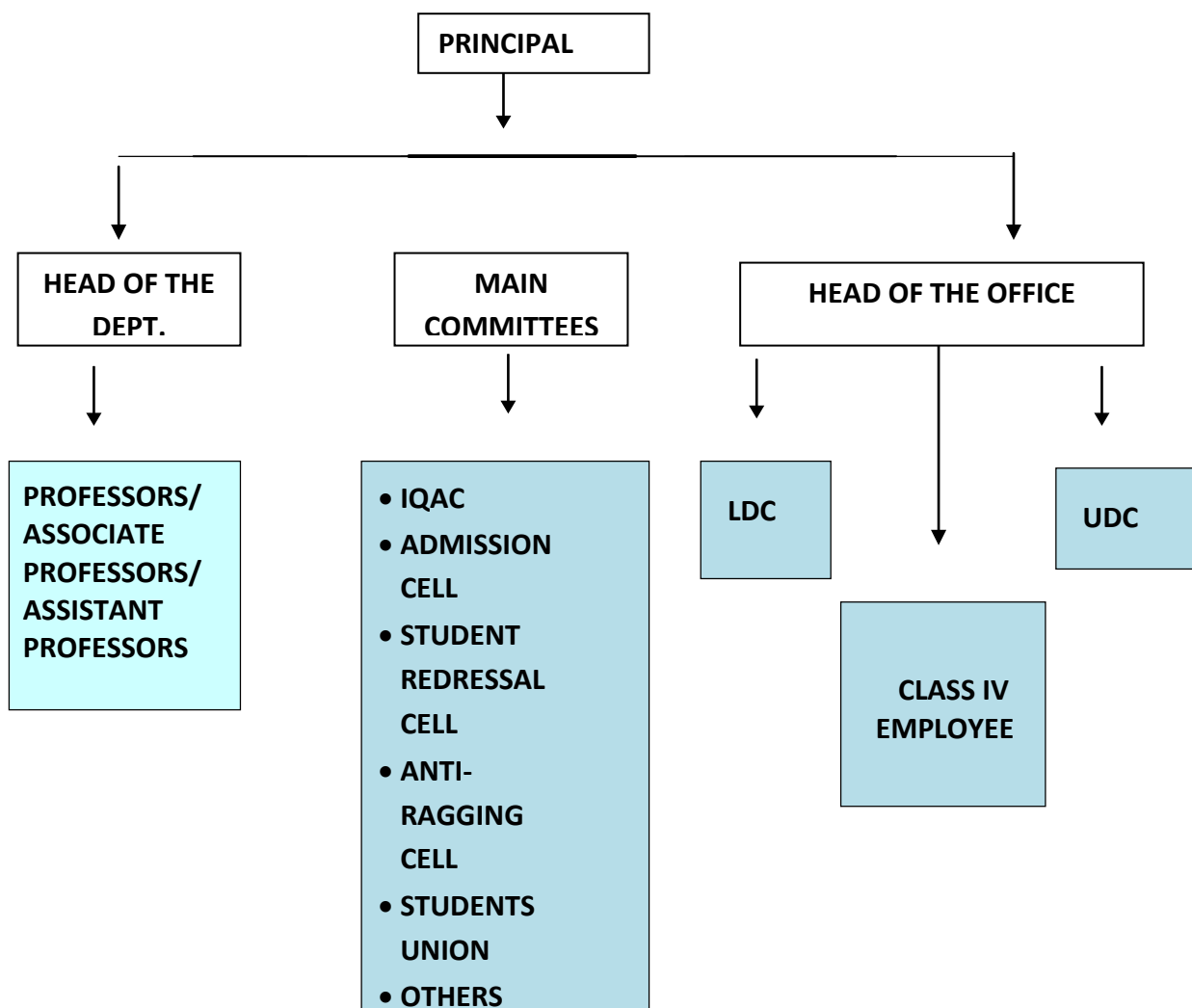

## 5. The Student Experience

Briefly describes student life in the college:

**Infrastructural facilities available to students** - Classrooms, Smart classrooms, laboratories and equipment, Common Research Lab, Hostel; Canteen; Garden; Students common room, Auditorium, Sports Complex & other facilities like, construction of ramps, railings and toilets are made available by the institution to meet the requirements of the students with physical disabilities. For the physically disabled classes are held on the ground floor. The residential facility and various provisions available within the institute are as follows:

- **An indoor hall** which serves as a make shift auditorium and an **open stage** are available in the college premises for educational and recreational purpose. **Sports room** also has the facility of providing games like carom-board and chess for recreation.
- A **common staff room** is also available for the facility of the staff.
- A **Girls' common room** is also available for the facility of the students.
- One **staff quarter** is there in the premises of the college.
- The college has constant supply of safe drinking water with the advanced facility of RO and aqua guard.

Admissions are made strictly according to the norms of Higher education assuring complete transparency in the admission process . The institution adheres to the reservation policy for ST/ST/OBC and differently abled students. Advertisement for admissions is done through the college prospectus and the college website <http://mlbggindore.com> the constant increase in the strength of students is a testament to the success of institute.

The teachers use various teaching methods to make the teaching-learning process effective. Academically weak students are provided help through notes and extra lectures. Students are encouraged to undertake projects, internship and field visits, which help in better comprehension and give them an opportunity to have a deeper and more practical knowledge about the subject. The highly qualified and competent teachers constantly strive for individual excellence and keep themselves abreast of the latest developments in their fields by attending national and international seminars, workshops and training courses.

A good infrastructure has been provided to all the departments which include well-established libraries and laboratories, projectors, computers with web access to make learning more students centric. The institution regularly organizes various curricular and co-

curricular activities to nurture critical thinking, creativity and scientific temper amongst students. Eminent scholars are invited here to deliver lectures on a various of topics, share their knowledge and experience with the students and teachers.

Literary clubs, exhibitions, and a various cultural and sports programmes provide students a platform to other case their talents. Student's academic capabilities are assessed through regular CCEs, group discussions, assignments, surprise tests and university exams. The institute also makes an effort to receive students feed-back on faculty performance.

- **Research Initiatives**

The institute employs well qualified instructors most of them with more than thirty years of experience. There are **52** regular professors, out of which **43** professors have Ph.D. degree. There are **28** guest faculties, out of which **19** have a doctoral degree, **02** have cleared NET and **02** have done SLET. **20** faculty members are registered guide. The Institute is a Centre for research in **08** subjects: Chemistry, Drawing& Painting, Dance, English, Home science and Psychology, Hindi & Economic. Duty leaves and study leaves are provided to teachers to Incentives research.

The Institute boasts of a main library, along with a library dedicated to each department to be used by teachers and students for research. The laboratories also lend themselves to research work by the faculty and the students.

In the year 2020-21, **11** students have been awarded Ph.D. degree and **27** papers have been published in National and international journals of repute. **386** seminars, **48** workshops, **57** Faculty Development Programmers and **45** Short Terms Courses have been attended by the faculty, ensuring that they were making the most of the lock- down during the covid-19 pandemic.

- **Administrative Initiatives**

The Principal of the institution appoints an administrative officer responsible for looking after administrative tasks. The IQAC is formed at the lee ginning of every session to plan the quality enhancement and progress of the institution. Many committees are also created under the principal's guidance to execute the IQAC's plan.

The principal also holds meetings with the alumni, stake-holders and students of the institute, intuiting suggestions for its improvement. At latest **2** times a year , staff council meeting are held to discuss significant issues like admission , student union election , examination etc.

The Heads of the departments are given the freedom and flexibility to exercise their

decisions in making decisions in the interest of the students and the institution. A variety of welfare schemes like GIS, GPF, Medical leave and maternity leave are made available to the teaching and non-teaching staff. The institution makes sure the grievances/complaints are promptly attended to and resolved effectively by concerned committees.

Class III and IV employers' recruitment and grievances and decisions regarding official and financial matters are made in meetings with the office staff, supervised by the Principal.

By the end of the session all the proposed and implemented plans are evaluated and reviewed by the Principal and the members of IQAC.

The institute also receives additional fund through self-finance courses, which are used for its development and the disbursement of salary to the teachers working under such courses. The accounts of the institute are audited by internal and external auditors.

### **Student Support**

The record of student's progression in the academic year 2020-21 has been quite remarkable. Renowned scholars and experts are also invited to deliver lectures and enlighten students, especially about proper communication skills, spoken English and overall personality development. Despite their conservative backgrounds, many girls avail job opportunities like running their boutiques, coaching classes, serving in schools as, teachers and working as dietitians in well-known hospitals. departments like Commerce, Computer Science, Psychology, English, Home Science, Mathematics, Drawing & Painting and Dance encourage the students to be self- dependent and develop their entrepreneurial skills. Activity clubs, on the other hand, help in grooming their personality.

### **Events & Intiatives**

The institute dedicates special attention to the effective implementation of curricular and co-curricular activities. The teaching staff made sure to adhere to the academic calendar issued by the Dept of higher Education.

Each department formed an activity club to Organize various activates like group discussion, paper presentation, impromptu story writing competition, quiz and talent search programmers. The students displayed their creativity and imagination with the help of power point presentation.
